




DUNCAN ELLISON SAFE WATER AWARD

- Duncan was also named an honorary member of CIPHI in 2008.





Malaria:

- Around 625,000 people die each year and 240+ million fall ill
- 70% of them are children under 5
- #1 killer of pregnant women
- Malaria is preventable
- 100% of public donations buys long-lasting insecticidal nets (LLINs).
 An LLIN costs US\$2.00
- The Foundation works with distribution partners to distribute nets and ensure use
- Conduct net use surveys and track monthly malaria data
