Environmental Health Foundation of Canada Financial Review

January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022

This is a report on the financial status of the Environmental Health Foundation of Canada (EHFC) for the 2022 calendar year. This is in keeping with the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) financial accounting system and the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) reporting system.

- The signing officers are Mike LeBlanc, Pamela Scharfe, Ralph Stanley and Lena Parker. Any two are authorized as joint signing officers.
- The EHFC has a Chequing Account with the Haney Branch of the Bank of Montréal (BMO) in Maple Ridge, BC.
- The funds of the EHFC as of January 1, 2022 consisted of \$27,749.59 in the Chequing Account with BMO. As of December 31, 2022, the Chequing Account with BMO consisted of \$8.323.24.
- 4. In addition, the EHFC has numerous Guaranteed Investment Certificates (GICs) with BMO, totalling \$175,396.50 as of December 31, 2022.
- 5. The total assets of the EHFC as of December 31, 2022 are \$183,719.74.

We have examined the financial records of the Environmental Health Foundation of Canada for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. We have found these transactions to be correct and accounting to be in good order.
